

Fire Safety -- Fire Prevention in Highland Hills

Fire prevention in Highland Hills has three major aspects: (1) Knowing our written policy on controlled burning – i.e., what’s allowed and what’s not; (2) Knowing our written policy on annual mowing for both homeowners and undeveloped property owners; and (3) Knowing you local fire department.

Controlled Burning in Highland Hills

In October of 2008, a new policy was enacted by the HHMC Board of Directors which banned residential burning in Highland Hills. Board Policy 3-6 details this change and describes what kind of controlled burns may yet occur, e.g., recreational fires.
