DEFINITIONS

Accidents - mainly one vehicle incidents with cars/trucks going off the roadway hitting signs or damaging property

Dogs - mainly loose dogs; there was one incident of dogs attacking a being-walked dog

Driveway Prowl - potential criminal seen in driveway but left or was scared off

Driving Safety - lane visibility, faded signs, intersection confusion, gravel on the road, tailgating

Fires - there have been two chimney fires and one car fire

Parking - blocking the roadway

Scammers - door to door magazine sellers

Skateboarders - youth/other going too fast on skateboards, in-line skates or bicycles

Traffic Violations - mainly running STOP signs; there were two incidents of dangerous/inappropriate passing

Trapping - illegal setting of animal traps (a domestic cat was injured)

Uninvited Visitors - refers to suspicious persons lurking, hanging around, asking strange questions

Vandalism - mainly mailbox and light post damage; there was one rock through a house window incident

OBSERVATIONS

1. Half of all incidents involve the use of our roadways.
2. Speeding remains our most frequent incident -- about 1 in every 4 reported incidents.
3. Vandalism remains our second most frequent incident with half of the vandalism incidents in the last eleven years have occurring in 2007 through 2009.
4. 2009, in terms of reported incidents, was very close to our eleven year average of 14.
5. 38% (5 of 13) of the incidents in 2009 were caused by resident teenagers.
